A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REFRAMING DOWNTOWN SPRINGVILLE MAIN STREET
CORRIDOR STUDY.

WHEREAS the Springville General Plan identifies the historic downtown area as an economic development area and also as a vital part of Springville's identity; and

WHEREAS Springville City Council directed Community Development staff to conduct a Main Street Corridor Study; and

WHEREAS a Main Street Corridor Study Ad-Hoc Committee was established at the direction of the Mayor and approval of the City Council; and

WHEREAS the Ad-Hoc Committee diligently worked, with the assistance of City Staff, Design Workshop, Fehr and Peers and representatives of UDOT, UTA and downtown business and property owners to consider the best possibilities for creating a vibrant and inviting historic downtown within Springville; and

WHEREAS the Ad-Hoc Committee and project team hosted online survey and mapping exercises, and in person public outreach, to capture citizen sentiment about Downtown Main Street to identify opportunities and challenges; and

WHEREAS, the Community Board received and reviewed a draft of Reframing Downtown Main Street Corridor Study and recommended adoption of the plan at a public meeting held September 14, 2023; and

WHEREAS the Planning Commission received and reviewed a draft of the Main Street Corridor Study and conducted a properly noticed public hearing and recommended adoption of the plan at a public meeting on September 23, 2023; and

WHEREAS the City Council reviewed the proposed plan at a meeting held September 19, 2023;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Municipal Council of the City of Springville, Utah, establishes, authorizes, and adopts the Reframing Downtown Springville's Downtown Main Street Corridor Plan as the City Council's guide for the development of the Downtown Main Street Corridor.
