

Commercial Shell Building Permit Checklist

To register with City Inspect, please visit <https://www.springvilleutah.gov/community-development/building-division/>

Permits will not be accepted as incomplete submissions.

Items to include when submitting for a building permit:

- Completed Building Permit application
- Plan check fee is due in FULL at time of permit submission. Contact office staff for amount.
- Water shares tendered (if not previously done with development)

One COMPLETE set of non-secured construction plans, in a .pdf format, submitted on the City Inspect portal, which includes:

- Plat or site plan (approved through DRC)
- Cover sheet showing design information (code analysis) showing allowable area, stories, identified occupancy groups proposed, proposed occupant loads, type of construction and fire resistive construction and accessibility requirements (endorsed by licensed design professional)
- Engineering (if required) with endorsement and calculations
- Structural Design/Architectural drawings with endorsements (shall include all wall types and materials proposed with shell building)
- Water meter and PI shown on site plan (cannot be located in driveway)
- Electrical/Mechanical/Plumbing with appropriate endorsements for stubs and service level Equipment
- Electrical Service Information Request form and primary power plan from site plan approval
- Truss Engineering and layout from manufacturer or structural steel package
- ComCheck or ASHREA 90.1 compliance information for energy envelope (includes windows, doors, walls, ceiling or roof and slab installations)
- ADA compliance with 2009 ANSI for egress paths and entrance to shell building
- Geotechnical report
- Special inspector information
- Construction valuation (bid may be submitted)

Process after submission for a Building Permit:

1. Complete submittals are reviewed on a first-come-first-serve basis
2. Plan review can take several weeks depending on the current demand

Requirements when picking up Building Permit:

Payment of impact fees and bonds by **CASH or CHECK ONLY**, made payable to Springville City. Other building permit fees can be paid with cash or check, or a debit or credit card, up to \$3,000.

Preconstruction meeting required for all multi-family and commercial projects prior to construction start.

Please request inspections through the City Inspect portal.
