Fire Restriction Order

Due to current and forecasted weather conditions coupled with the record dry fuel conditions and extreme fire danger throughout the state, the Utah State Forester, in consultation with the undersigned county sheriffs, has determined that measures must be taken to prevent the ignition of wildfires. Therefore, pursuant to Utah State Law, Title/Section 65A-8-212, the following acts are prohibited in the areas described below until rescinded by the State Forester:

1. Use of any steel component ammunition of any caliber.
2. Use of any steel component target.

Area Description: All state lands and unincorporated private lands within the Lake Mountains, in and south of the cities of Saratoga Springs and Eagle Mountain, and north of Soldiers Pass Road, as depicted on the attached map. This order does not apply to the Utah County Soldier Pass Public Shooting Range.

This order will be in place for 14 days, after which it will be reviewed by the signers and either be renewed or rescinded depending on fire danger.

Any of the above acts is a violation of state law and is punishable by up to 6 months in jail and a fine of up to \$1,000. These restrictions will be enforced by Division of Law Enforcement and local law enforcement.
